- ◆ Sustainable agriculture for bio-based economy.
- ◆ The state and deployment of bioeconomy in Poland and the CEE countries.

Proceedings

Papers sent in English that pass successfully review procedure will be published in the III ISC conference proceedings. It is recommended that the volume of a paper should not exceed 8 pages. The editorial requirements can be found on the website.

The publication will be released after the conference in paper and electronic version. Submission of scientific articles takes place via the OJS system.
