

Distribution of H2020 SC2 budget over priorities (EUR million - 2014-2020)







- Adopted 11 October 2018
- Better synergies with CAP
- More emphasis on rural development
- Articulation with EIP-AGRI
- "Living labs" for innovation in primary production

- Proposed in June 2018
- Knowledge, innovation and digitalisation a cross-cutting objective
- CAP strategic plans to foster innovation (art. 95.1.g)

→Description of the elements that ensure modernisation of the CAP: AKIS, advisory services, digitisation strategies...

- EIP-AGRI continued and reinforced
- Development of bioeconomy is encouraged
- 10 B € proposed for agricultural R&I
