Does Slovenia need a special Bioeconomy Strategy?

### What are our target sectors for bioeconomy?

- Forestry & Wood Processing Industry cca 60% of Slovenia is covered by forests (4th most forested country in Europe), 8 million m<sup>3</sup> annual growth, a lot of untapped opportunities
- Pulp & Paper Industry
- Agriculture & Food Processing Industry a source of biomass and by-products
- Manufacturing Industry with potenial for manufacturing bio-based products, e.g. chemical, pharmaceutical, biotechnology, plastic industry
- Fresh Water Aquaculture Slovenia is rich with fresh water (28.000 km water courses, 1.300 lakes above 1 ha)
